

Benefits Gained by Implementation

- Standardizes company content and structure and limits company customization
 - We all follow the same regulatory requirements
 - Inspectors are the same across companies
 - Company-specific requirements are often driven by tradition, legacy or personal opinion
- Simplifies engagement of CROs and other third parties
- Simplifies consolidation of disparate documents into a single TMF structure (in real time, at defined trial events and/or at study end)

Deliverables to Date

- Meeting twice a month since October 2017
- Created and finalized: Change Control Procedure, RACI and CR Tracker
- Reviewed and categorized all current change requests
- Triaging all change requests to Zone Teams



Version Definition

- Maintenance release e.g. v3.0.1
 - e.g. minor typographic changes, clarification, sub-artifacts
- Minor release e.g. v3.1
 - Substantial change in content but no compatibility issues e.g. additional optional column (milestones)
- Major release e.g. v4.0
 - Change likely to have compatibility issues with prior version e.g. addition/removal of artifacts










What does the eTMF Exchange Mechanism provide?

Human vs system-based communication

- Mechanism
 - Mouth->ears or hands->eyes
- Common language
 - English (to communicate outside native language)
- Shared protocol
 - Soundwaves or pen and paper
- Mechanism
 - APIs and/or standard parser (TMF EMS¹)
- Common language
 - The TMF Reference Model¹
- Shared protocol
 - XML (TMF EMS¹)






What part of business can benefit from the EMS?

Do you collaborate?

• Sponsor and CRO, Study sites, IRB/EC, Lab's...



How can this be done efficiently

- Ensure quality from the provider (Quality by Design) and be able to transfer the documented quality.
 - Issues caught early are easier and cheaper to fix.
 - The customer does not have to recheck the work. Only risk-based sampling.
- Oversight monitor the quality in real-time
 - Establish vendor oversight with minimal effort and as fast as possible.

The eTMF Exchange Mechanism Standard (EMS) can preserve and transfer GCP between collaborators!

- When established the EMS can easier be used by other collaborators.




